I Table Mat with Thumb Impression

- . Take an A3 sized pastel sheet.

- . Outline the pictures.
- . Show your creativity in making the table mat .
- . Get it laminated from the market.

- . Regular visit to Grocery shop, Fruit shop and Vegetable shop will help the little ones make a choice from the fruits and vegetables they would like to eat.
- . This activity enhances identification and colour recognition. Click pictures of the visit to these shops and paste them in handmade decorated scrapbook.

III Little hands at work

- . This activity will enhance pre-number concept of a child
- . Pre-number concept-Big and Small

Big-watermelon

- . Take a cut- out of a watermelon on a cardboard.
- . Colour the cut-out with red and green colour.
- . Collect the watermelon seeds, wash and dry them.
- . Paste the seeds on the cut-out of watermelon.

Small-orange

- . Take a cutout of an orange on a cardboard.
- . Colour it using orange colour.
- . Tear the orange colour paper and paste it on the cutout.

IV My creativity

Recognition of shapes

- . Draw the shapes , , , , , ,  on a cardboard 5" X 5"
- . Cut them separately with the help of your parents.
- . Draw eyes, nose and mouth on each shape.
- . Make hands and legs with pastel sheets.
- . keep them in transparent bag.

- . Get it laminated from the market.


VI Fun with Paper Bag

- Submit your holiday homework in this bag.**


